## An illustration of how the Arizona State Tax Credit Program works:

*The return shown is for illustrative purposes only.*

- 1) This 2022 tax return shows an Arizona state tax liability of \$1,231 (line 48).
- 2) It also shows that \$1,000 was contributed to Arizona's CTSO for tuition support (that's line 51 – the “tax credit” from Arizona Form 301).
- 3) The \$1,000 contribution was then deducted from the tax liability (the \$1,231 on line 48 minus the \$200 Dependent Tax Credit on line 49), leaving only \$31 as the balance of tax (line 52).
- 4) However, \$1,425 in taxes had already been withheld by the employer (line 53).
- 5) That means there was actually an overpayment of \$1,394 (line 61 – which is the \$1,425 withheld (line 53) less the \$31 Balance of Tax (line 52)).
- 6) So – the tax payers got a refund of \$1,394 after filing their return (line 79)!
- 7) What did it cost these people to contribute to the school of their choice?

### Absolutely nothing!

They simply redirected a portion of their state tax liability to a cause they wanted to support – quality Catholic education!
